- Paul Agonised to Proclaim Christ: v. 1 ¹For I want you to know how great a struggle I have for you and for those at Laodicea and for all who have not seen me face to face,
- Paul was Purposeful in Proclaiming Christ: v. 2 ²that their hearts may be encouraged, being knit together in love, to reach all the riches of full assurance of understanding and the knowledge of God's mystery, which is Christ,
- **Paul had Clarity About the Glories of Christ:** v. 3 ³*in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.*

⁶Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in him, ⁷<u>rooted</u> and <u>built up in him</u> and <u>established in the faith</u>, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving. ⁸See to it that no one takes you captive by philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition, according to the elemental spirits of the world, and <u>not according to Christ</u>.
